DESCRIPTION:

This session will address mental illness (MI) as it co-occurs with dementia. Various types of dementia (e.g., Dementia with Lewy Bodies, Frontotemporal dementia, and Alzheimer's disease) will be discussed, as well as misdiagnosis of dementia, MI, and delirium, the effects of brain changes in dementia on cognition, behavior, and functioning, and finally implications for intervention. Non-pharmacological intervention strategies that address psychosis and dementia and are individualized to the person, disorder(s), and situation will be explored.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Identify at least three types of dementia.
- 2. Identify at least three cognitive functions that are impaired in dementia due to dysfunction in specific parts of the brain.
- 3. Describe three symptoms of dementia that might look like MI and possibly lead to a misdiagnosis.
- 4. Identify two symptoms of delirium that might be misdiagnosed as MI or dementia.
- 5. Describe at least three interventions that address cognitive impairment in dementia and MI.
- 6. Describe at least two interventions that address psychosis in MI.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

- This training is intended for people who work with ACT consumers and others whose work includes people with confusing symptoms. This training is appropriate for social work practice levels of beginning, intermediate and/or advanced.
- This workshop counts as a MDHHS approved ACT specific training that meets the annual requirement for ACT workers.
- ACT workers will be given priority registration; others are also welcome.
