COVID 19 Health Precautions

The Arc NW recommends following the Center for Disease Control's (CDC) guidelines:

- Know how COVID 19 spreads:
- From person to person who are in close contact with each other
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

Wash your hands:

- Wash often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home if you are sick except to get medical care
- Cover coughs and sneezes with the inside of your elbow then wash your hands
- If you are sick wear a face mask to protect others
- If you are not sick you do not need a facemask unless caring for someone who is sick

<u>Member of the Year</u>

The Achiever of the Year award goes to an individual with developmental disabilities who strives to be the best they can be. This is someone who has made significant achievements in their efforts to gain independence and control of their life. Arc membership is desired but not required for the award.

Teacher/Education Team of the Year

Who would have thought that ALL SPORTS even the Summer Olympics in Japan would be cancelled! This is something I hope the world never sees again. The Coronavirus is putting a new chapter in history and medical books and we were here to witness it.

Basketball came to an end on March 9th when word was received the State Basketball Tournament at Calvin University in Grand Rapids was cancelled. This was especially hard to hear for the 3 teams and the coaches that were planning on packing their bags to head to Calvin for the weekend of March 20th. The Wolverines – Division 3 and Lightning – Division 4 teams won the Gold Medals at Northville District Tournament March 7th which gualified them to advance to the State Special Olympic Basketball Tournament along with the Lady Hot Shot team. The State Summer Games have not yet decided if they will happen or not but we should know in the near future. Please notify your athletes, coaches and families of this news. This is not what we want to hear but under these circumstances it is necessary to protect our athletes and families. That is the number 1 priority.

With a broken heart, I must announce the annual Sport Program Bowling fundraiser of May 1st at Westland Bowl is also cancelled. I have not ruled out a smaller bowling fundraiser towards the end of August. Once the bowling alley reopens and life goes back to normal I will look into this with the owner of Westland Bowl and all the wonderful volunteers that have helped me with the bowling event.




