Dear Friends,

It's great news that Michigan has more than 55% of our population vaccinated against COVID-19! We're glad to let you know that The Arc NW office building is fully open, but we are still being careful. We continue to follow CDC and MDHHS guidelines. Staff and visitors who are fully vaccinated will not need to wear face coverings in the building. Anyone who is <u>not fully vaccinated will need</u> to wear a face covering to be in the <u>building</u>. Unvaccinated staff will wear face coverings in the common spaces of the building. We still need to stay 6ft apart from one another and use good hand washing practices.

Lekotek is open for play sessions and toy lending using these same restrictions. We ask that no more than 2 visitors be in an office with one staff person at a time unless everyone is from the same family living together. We can have small gatherings of up to 8 people socially distanced in the conference room. We are thankful that everyone is staying healthy and safe. We're especially glad to be getting back to more "normal" life together.
